

SPIRITUAL COUNCIL NEWS

What is a disciple? This was the key question we discussed at our Spiritual Council meeting on July 15th, 2025. We believe that clearly defining discipleship is vital as we develop ministry plans to guide our areas of service in alignment with our church's mission: "To Know Him and Make Him Known." We are working toward a clear and biblical understanding of discipleship that every follower of Jesus in our congregation can embrace and apply in their lives as we seek to grow closer to God and share His love with others.

This month, we launched a new study for young couples called "Habits of the Household." We are encouraged by several aspects of this initiative. Firstly, we've seen a strong turnout, with at least six families attending weekly. The feedback has been very positive, with many couples sharing that they never had a Christian household to learn from and are finding that these habits are simple yet effective for discipling their children. So far, we have discussed good habits to implement upon waking in the morning, at bedtime, during mealtime, and for handling screens and technology. We've found that these habits are firstly important for the parent to implement in his or her own life, as well as establishing good habits for the rest of the family. Additionally, we praise God for how our church community has stepped up to provide meals and childcare for these families, ministering to the parents by allowing them to focus on strengthening their families.

Finally, we are excited to announce that a church membership class will begin in September, starting on the 14th. The class will take place after church services and will run for three weeks. Some of the items that will be covered include: the Gospel, our statement of faith, the history of St. Luke, and what it means to be a member of our church community. Church Council News

The Council met for its regular monthly meeting on Tuesday July 1st. The devotion was presented by Denise Kaullen.

Following the devotion message and prayer the meeting was called to order by Don Borgman. The agenda for the meeting and the minutes for the May27th meeting were approved as presented. Financial reports for the month of June were also approved as presented.

There were no reports this month from the Pre-school, Cemetery or Endowment Committees. Pastor Scott discussed his first few days at St Luke which included participation in Vacation Bible School. Pastor expressed how impressed he is with the organization of VBS and the wonderful experience it is for all. He also discussed his ministry plans for the coming weeks and months and his focus in particular on "disciples making disciples".

Under Old Business several maintenance and capital improvement projects were discussed. These include the construction of the shelter house being built east of the CCC and adjacent to the playground (Council discussed this is going to be a great addition to the St Luke campus); Parsonage upgrades which included painting, removal of carpet and installation of laminate flooring, and miscellaneous repairs; power washing of the church, the parsonage and the front of the CCC; and the resealing /restriping of the parking lots which was underway. It was discussed that repairs to the sewer line has been delayed due to the work schedule of the contractor. Many thanks to the Building and Grounds Committee for all the work they have been doing!

Also, under Old Business the status of the church and cemetery incorporation projects was discussed. Presently we are waiting on survey of the church land and cemetery to be completed. We are also waiting on the title company to finish reviewing the legal title to the property. Under New Business, the Council briefly discussed the Ministry Plan being developed by the Spiritual Council and inquired about the status of the plan for the upcoming budget discussions coming up in the fall.

Finally, Council discussed the annual Patriots Day Celebration and special thanks to Sally Nadler and the Nadler family for initiating and sponsoring this wonderful outreach event. With no further business to consider, the meeting was adjourned.
